

Fayette County Republican Women Scholarship
Information and Criteria

In 2020, the Fayette County Republican Women will award a \$1,000.00 scholarship to one graduating, college-bound (including 4-year, 2 year or vocational schools), senior girl from each Fayette County high school who has demonstrated outstanding leadership skills and conservative qualities. A total of five scholarships will be given. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the recipient's college or educational institution.

Applicants will be evaluated based on their leadership activities in local organizations, conservative values and goals, recommendations from teachers and community leaders, and an essay written by the applicant.

The applicant must be a graduating senior girl who is a resident of Fayette County and attends one of the following: Round Top-Carmine High School, Fayetteville High School, Flatonia High School, Schulenburg High School, or La Grange High School. FCRW members, friends and family are not prohibited from applying.

A complete application must include the following:

- Official application form, all sections completed in full
- Three letters of recommendation (recommendation form attached).
- A copy of your most recent high school transcript, a minimum 2.5 grade point average is required
- Because the short answer essay questions on our application are particular to the causes and principles for which our organization stands, we cannot accept or consider to substitution of a generic scholarship application.

All original applications must be mailed to the Scholarship Chairman (Carole Bourlon), postmarked, by April 15, 2020. School contacts will be notified of their recipient no later than May 1, 2020.
